YEAR IN REVIEW



2023/24 brought incredible growth for Momentum.

The year began with planning for our clinic move, where we said goodbye to Centre 104 and relocated to Argyll Centre in June. We were incredibly proud of our successful transition to our new location. We moved to virtual services for two weeks where a small but mighty group of us (and our spouses and family members) completed the entire relocation. It was an amazing feat that avoided any downtime or closures!

We were very fortunate to receive funding for an additional part-time Clinical Supervisor position. In March, we welcomed back Jennifer Thomson, co-founder of the Walk In Counselling Society of Edmonton (WICSOE), the precursor to Momentum!

Given our ongoing funding challenges, we procured a grant to initiate a fund development strategy. We continue to implement the recommendations as time and resources allow, which are proving to increase our overall capacity. Our growth included new partnerships with a number of local nonprofit agencies, providing on-site mental healthcare to their clients and community members.

Over the course of the year, we noticed our clients preferred in-person sessions over virtual for the first time since the pandemic. We responded by adding additional in-person as well as evening appointments. We also observed that while many clients benefit from a single session, others benefitted from ongoing therapy. Fortunately, many of our graduating clinical interns chose to remain, and offered additional support that complemented our counselling program.


We also heard from clients who participated in our support groups, looking for new offerings. Again, we responded with more options, resulting in groups running daily!
